



Out Of School Dance Related Functions



Students who wish to represent the
THE SALEM DANCE NETWORK,
by participating in out of school dance related events,
must abide by the following mandatory requirements:

1. Proper Studio Attire - At all times - Regardless of whether there is no dress code.

- a. Ballet Uniform - SDN Leotard / Seamed Ballet Pink Tights / Dance Shoes
Jazz/Tap Uniform - SDN Leotard / Black Tights / Dance Shoes
Ballet/Jazz/Tap -SDN Leotard / Ballet Pink Tights / Black Jazz Pants / Dance Shoes
- b. Travel Uniform - *SDN Warm Up Suit / SDN Tank / SDN Sweat Shirt / SDN Jacket / Black Jazz Sneakers / SDN Dance Bag / SDN ID Tag
*(Or SDN T-Shirt, Black Sweat Pants, Black Sweat Shirt, White Canvas Sneakers, Dance Bag, Emergency Information)
- c. Hair - Tight, Slick, Low Bun, Parted On The Left / Studio Floral Hair Piece / Absolutely No Bangs Or Wispy Ends /
No Colored Elastics, Scrunches, Barrettes, etc. / Only Use Black, Brown, Silver & Gold
- d. No, No's - No Jewelry / No Nail Polish / No Tattoos / No Undergarments / No Holes In Leotards / No Runs In Tights

2. Arrive Early, Never Late - Leave Enough Time For Travel.

3. Remain For The Entire Duration - Under No Circumstances Should You Be Dismissed Early

- a. Only In The Case Of An Emergency (Birthday Parties & Family Outings Are Not Considered Emergencies)

4. Students Are Expected To Attend All Of Their Regularly Scheduled Classes At The SDN.

- a. Make-Up Classes Will Be Mandatory For Classes Missed.
- b. Only in the event of a rehearsal schedule conflict will students be allowed to miss a regularly scheduled class with Director's Consent.

5. Rules

- a. No Jewelry - No Nail Polish - No Tattoos - No Gum
- b. No Holes In Leotards - No Runs In Tights - No Undergarments
- c. Tight, Slick Low Bun, Parted On The Left - No Bangs Or Wispy Ends
- d. No Colored Elastics, Scrunches, Barrettes, Etc. Only Use Black, Brown, Silver & Gold
- e. Ballet Shoes Must Have Elastics Sewn On - Bows Tucked In
- f. Students Must Be In Studio Uniform At All Times - Regardless Of Whether There Is No Dress Code
- g. White Canvas Sneakers Should Look Brand New - Not Dirty
- h. Keep All Gear Zipped Up In Dance Bag - Neat & Efficient - (In Designated Area - Under Chair/Bench, Etc.)
- i. Arrive Early - Never Late - Remain For The Entire Duration - No Early Dismissals
- j. Use The Bathroom During Break Or In Between Classes Only
- k. No Talking In Class - Eyes On The Instructor
- l. No Sitting In Class - Unless Directed To Do So By The Instructor
- m. Be Courteous To Other Dancers
- n. Do Your Best - Keep A Smile On Your Face - & HAVE FUN!!!!!!!!!!!!!!!!!!!!!!

Please Read Carefully

Out of school dance events are not ideal for students who can not tolerate a rigorous schedule.

Students must be able to balance school, SDN classes, outside rehearsals, & any other commitments they may have.

This is not ideal for students who frequently fall ill during allergy season, flu season, etc.

However, it is a great opportunity for the serious student.
